Wildlife drive

- Open Fridays, Saturdays, Sundays and federal holidays.
- Speed limit: 10 miles per hour
- Maximum vehicle length: 25 feet
- No trailers allowed.
- Follow directional signs. Drive is one way.
- Stop only at pullover areas.

Caution: The wildlife drive intersects and shares the levee road with hikers, bicycle riders and other users along the lake front.

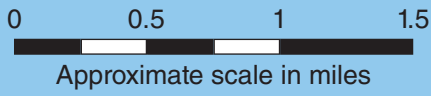
Historic pump house
